These last several years he has competed in Eventing Horse Trials. He has been a judge for 16 years and is carded with the Palomino Horse Breeders Assoc., the Pinto Horse Assoc., the American Miniature Horse Assoc. and the Pony of the Americas Club. Dave instructs several students during the show season and conducts clinics throughout the year. He is an at-large member of the NYS 4-H Horse Education Committee and a member of the Equine Leaders Group in NY. He also is a director and past President of the Empire State Quarter Horse Assoc. He volunteers throughout the year at many 4-H events.

Kyle Quartaro is an 18 year old competitor! Involved with horses for the past 10 years, he started showing horses at age 12 at the local county fair. His niche is showing horses "draft-style", showing everything from halter horses through driving multiples in hitch classes. This past year he showed at 14 county fairs, NYS Fair, Eastern States Expo in MA, the FL State Fair and a few open shows, parades, plow-matches, etc. He enjoys working with other youth, and feels there is a strong demand for youth in the horse industry.

Becca Palmer is 18 years old and has been involved in horses her entire life. Her family (Honey Locust Farms) is strongly involved in the draft horse business: breeding, selling, carriage service, and showing draft horses. She, with her family, shows everything from halter horses up to a six horse hitch; competing at several county fairs in New York State, along with the NYS fair. She enjoys fitting horses for the show-ring and presenting them in front of a judge. She always looks forward to seeing new youth in the classes.
